



COVID—19 Policies and Procedures

Due to the Covid-19 (coronavirus) pandemic, the Local 234 JATF training site is taking proactive steps to address several concerns regarding training and instruction. First and foremost, we want to maintain a safe workplace for our employees and a safe training atmosphere for our members. We ask all members to cooperate in taking steps to reduce the transmission of this communicable disease. Below you will find the policies and procedures we will be following.

If you feel Sick

All members are encouraged to stay home if they are sick. Do not attend class or show up to operate a piece of equipment if you are experiencing respiratory symptoms such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, body aches, headache, chills or fatigue.

Social Distancing

Social (physical) distancing involves maintaining at least six feet of distance between people and is an effective way to help reduce the risk of exposure to the coronavirus. Instructors and members are encouraged to practice social distancing in the classroom, shop area and in the field.

Personal Protective Equipment

Face masks will be provided for any and all members that choose to wear face coverings. Facial coverings are not required in the equipment, but the equipment will be sanitized after each member's use.

Sanitizing and Cleaning Practices

All surfaces, such as door handles, machine levers, steering wheels, switches, chairs and tables will be cleaned and disinfected daily by a member of the JATF staff.

All members who operate equipment will be given alcohol/disinfectant wipes to clean high contact area in the equipment or vehicle they are operating. Additional wipes or disinfectant will be provided if requested.

Please remove all trash from the equipment when leaving for the day.

Temperature Check

All members, training site employees and visitors will be subject to a temperature scan. No one will be allowed to enter the training site unless this scan has been completed and the person's temperature is in the normal range showing no signs of a fever.
